Smart Phone Apps		
App	Availability	Information
bSafe you	Free for iPhone & Android	SOS Alarm Mode, call 911 & video record in case of emergency. Share your location with friends via GPS. Allow friends to be notified when you are home. Select "fake call" for bad dates.
Aspire News	Free for iPhone & Android	Disguised as a news app. GO Button sends pre-typed or pre-recorded message to multiple contacts & 911 and begins recording (used for evidence). Help section contains resources for victims of domestic violence. Ability to exit app at any time, will take you back to news page.
One Love	Free for iPhone & Android	Provides a danger assessment and risk factors depending on score. Provides information regarding relationship violence. Can be used with professionals (therapist, advocate, etc.). Disables after one use, can re-download. 24/7 chat with peer advocates available.
Life 360	Free for iPhone & Android	Start a "family circle" of trusted contacts. Provides GPS access to "circle." Panic Button- calls, emails & texts all members in "circle." Can check in @ location. Add "Home" as location of work, school, etc. where contacts can be notified when you arrive.

Provides insight on barriers to safety for victims. Shifts conversation to how bystanders can support and invest in the safety of domestic violence victims.
Facebook	Social Media Site	Keep yourself safe by enabling privacy settings. Ability to report harmful material. Use a generic profile photo. Ask friends not to disclose information about you. Ability to block people from viewing your profile. Change username/ password often. Print copies of electronic abuse & keep in safe place (for evidence).
NET10 Phone	Walmart, Target, Convenience stores 1 (877) 836-2368	No contract, pay as you go phone. No cancellation fee. Minutes and data can be purchased on airtime calling cards. Activate online or by calling toll free number. Provides emergency calling capability to 911.
