

Participants Needed for Research Study on Parenting after Incarceration

Are you a parent who has been previously incarcerated and struggle with opioid use currently or in the past?

You May Qualify If You:

- Were incarcerated and released from jail within the last 10 years
- Were a parent of a child 0-17 years old at the time of your release from incarceration
- Have a history or current opioid use/misuse
- You have access to a private location and the ability to connect via Zoom by phone or computer

Participation Involves:

- Brief online pre-interview questionnaire
- 45-60 minute interview over Zoom focused on:
 - Your reentry and parenting experiences
 - Challenges you experienced
 - Ways you could have been better supported during reentry
